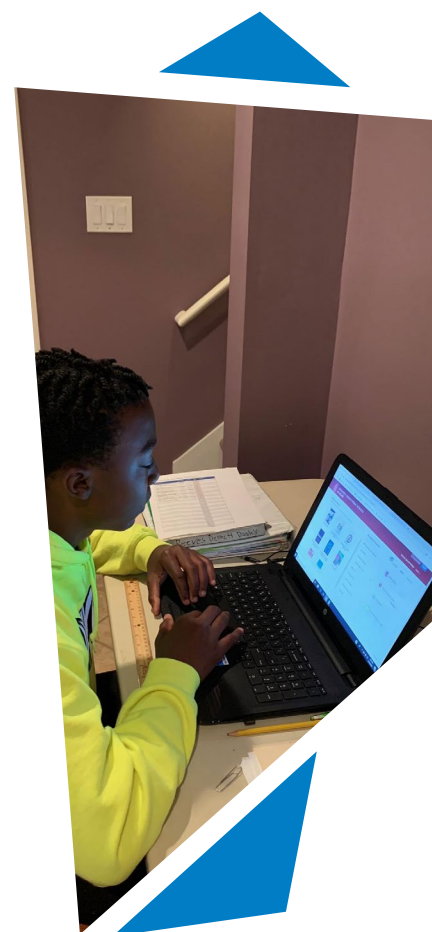


Science and Math Online Resources for Middle Schoolers
