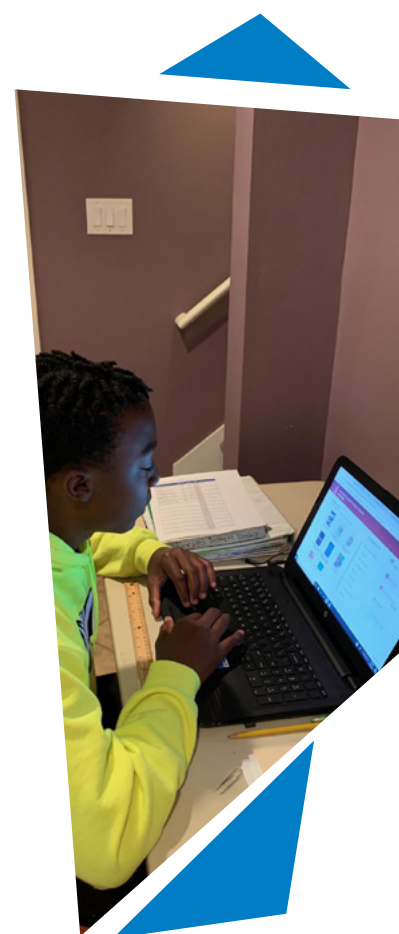




SCIENCE AND MATH ONLINE RESOURCES FOR MIDDLE SCHOOLERS
