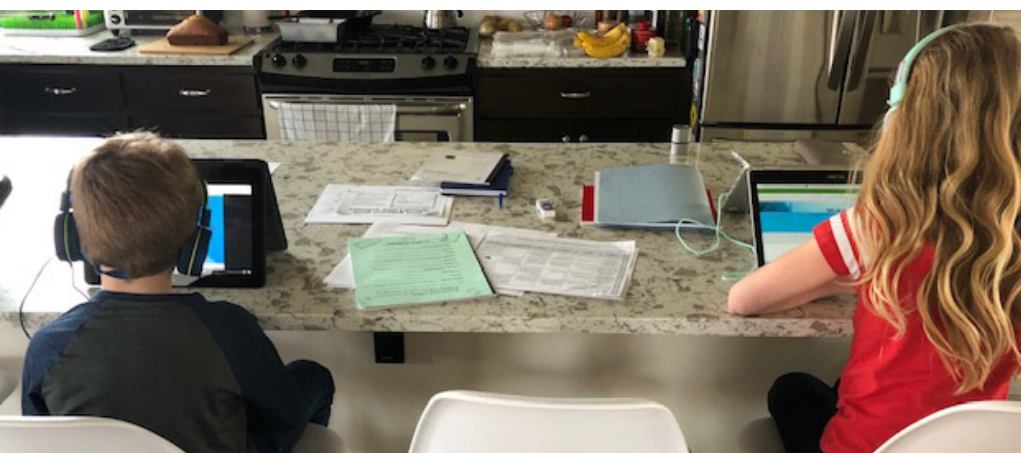




# 10 THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN SETTING UP REMOTE LEARNING FOR ELEMENTARY AGE KIDS

1. Create a flexible schedule with your child to provide structure.

2. With your child, decide what type of environment would be best and most comfortable for learning. (Desk, floor, music, quiet place, background noise, natural lighting, etc.)
3. Think about the technology and devices that your child will use. (Internet, mobile device, headset, ear buds, etc.)
4. Provide hands-on art supplies. (Paper supplies, Post-its, scissors, pen/markers/crayons/watercolors, etc.)
5. Create a “Parking Lot” question area where your child can post questions when you are not available.
6. [Establish Digital Citizenship norms](#) to reinforce how to keep your children safe online.
7. Create a personalized learning “playlist” of “[Must Do's](#)” and “[May Do's](#)” activities to promote positive, self-directed learning choices.
8. Provide learning opportunities through “[choice boards](#)” to enhance educational experiences and personal passion projects.
9. Include a visual calendar or task list of agreed-upon home chores and activities for your child.
10. Have your child set up their own task-list reminder system to keep their space clean and to document when they have completed their learning projects.
